Invigilators help to make sure the right candidates are in the right places. They give out vital information such as start and finish times for exams and ensure candidates have all the materials and information needed for each exam. They also prevent cheating. Working as a team, invigilators contribute to ensuring a calm environment for the exams, giving candidates confidence in the process and freeing up teachers to focus on teaching. We are looking for some more invigilators to help oversee our Summer examinations. Invigilators need to be:

- punctual
- highly flexible
- able to relate to learners
- comfortable in a high-pressure environment.

It's a part-time role, but one that can make a real difference.

You will need to have availability between 7 May and 29 June for sessions which run between 8.15 – 12.30 and/or 13.00 – 16.30.
