ROAD SAFETY WEEK 30 JUNE - 4 JULY

Various events will take place in school during this week to highlight to students the importance of keeping safe on the roads. The police will do a police patrol to advise on the journey to school and traffic wardens will be available after school to advise on safe parking for parents. There will also be various curriculum activities during the week related to Road safety as well as Road Safety assemblies.

On Monday 30 June during Period 1&2 Year 8 will have an activity session with Philip Archer, Road Safety Education Officer. At lunchtime on Tuesday and Wednesday the Police Community Support Officer will be stamping bikes with postcodes and the road safety team will be checking the safety of bikes.
